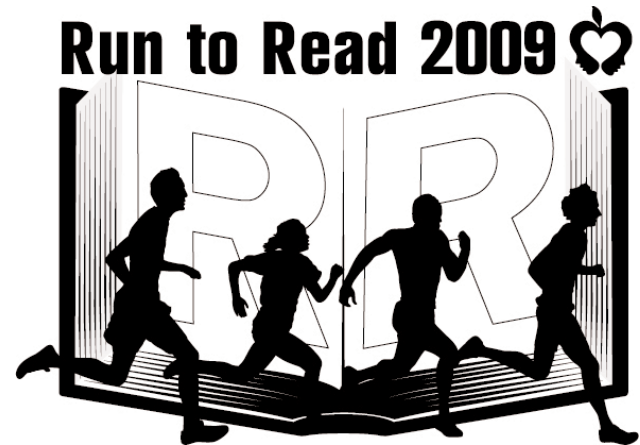

### Course/Times

The 5K (3.1 mile) run takes place on a USATF-certified course (IL-07023-JW) over mostly flat roads. The start and finish are at Dirksen School. See map online at [www.sd54.org/SD54/runtoread.htm](http://www.sd54.org/SD54/runtoread.htm). Split times will be called out at the 1-, 2- and 3-mile marks. A digital clock will be at the finish line.

**ABSOLUTELY NO** bicycles, skates, scooters, wheeled vehicles or pets are allowed on the 5K run, according to the Chicago Area Runners Association regulations. Strollers will be allowed on the walk.

### Directions and Parking

Race day packet pickup and registration will be held in the Dirksen School gym, 116 Beech Drive in Schaumburg. From Interstate 90 exit at Roselle Road south, go past Schaumburg Road. Turn right on Beech Drive. Free parking is available at the school, on side streets and behind the school in Schaumburg’s Town Square.

### Packet Pickup at Dick Pond Athletics

Packet pickup will be available in the gym on the morning of the race. Participants who registered by Sept. 22 will also be able to pick up their packets from 11 a.m.-9 p.m. on Thursday, Sept. 24, from 10 a.m.-6 p.m. on Friday, Sept. 25, and from 10 a.m.-5 p.m. on Saturday, Sept. 26 at Dick Pond Athletics, 927 S. Roselle Road in Schaumburg. Thank you to Dick Pond for hosting.

### Time

- 7-8:30 a.m. race-day registration and packet pickup. **You must register for the 5K race by 8 a.m.**
- 7:50 a.m. warmup for kids’ races
- 8 a.m. 100 yard dash starts                      8:15 a.m. 400 yard dash starts
- 8:30 a.m. 5K race starts                              8:45 a.m. family fun walk starts
- 9:40 a.m. 5K award ceremony and drawing in the gym.

### Water Stations/Restrooms

There will be a water station in the gym and another on the course. Restrooms will be available in the school.

### Awards (5K only)

Awards will be presented at 9:40 a.m. in the Dirksen gym to the top male and female winner and the top 3 men and women in each of these age groups: 14 and under, 15-19, 20-29, 30-39, 40-49, 50-59, 60-69, 70 and over. All children in the sprint races will receive a medal at the finish line. 5K winners may pick up their medal at the District Office (between 8 a.m. and 4 p.m. Monday-Friday) if they choose not to stay for the ceremony.
